From Chairman's Desk

One of the most significant achievement during period is publication of state of the art edited book entitled "Crop Residue Burning and Management Strategies for Safe Environment". The book was distributed to all stake holders and helped in moderating paddy straw burning problem. Another MOU was signed with alpha planters to test the efficiency of pots and trenches fabricated by the company in terms of water use efficiency, plant growth, nutrition and to suggest modifications in structural design to provide favourable micro climate conductive to rest growth in pots and trenches. The long and short term experiments such as identification of water saving climate smart crops and management identification practices; evaluation of promising rice varieties under changing climate scenario; rice residue management strategy and seed production of promising rice varieties were continued. A Kissan Divas was also organized to link agricultural research innovations with farmers and to supply qualiitety seeds as mini kits.

Several working and retired scientists visited the research and education centre, school students exposure visits were organized to link them with theory and practical of agricultural sciences. The Chairman visited Bali, Indonesia and presented a paper in the ICID conference. Being Chairman of CRIDA, RAC visited Hyderabad and conducted First RAC meeting. The Chairman also visited IISR, Lucknow; CIIRD, Chandigarh; NASC, New Delhi; CSSRI, Karnal; CII, Chandigarh and NDDB, Anand to deliver key note addresses and to Chair technical sessions in workshops and seminars.

Linking Primary School Students with Agricultural Research and Education and Development

As a part of farm visit and an agro-eco tourism venture a group of about 150 students of standard first accompanied by their teachers and supporting staff visited G S Foundation for Research, Education and Development Centre near Kachhwa today (30 Sept, 2019) in the morning. The visiting students had the opportunity to see all kind of rabi crops, vegetables, fruits, aromatic and medicinal plants grown at the research station.



They also interacted with the animals particularly goats, poultry, rabbits, ducks, dairy animals and mare kept at the farm as a part of an integrated farming system model to double farmers income. The Chairman demonstrated the functioning of gobar gas plant established for generating cooking gas for domestic use and slury for application in the field to improve soil fertility.
